Regulation 4 requires the owner of a bovine animal kept on any premises to mark or identify that animal in an approved manner, within 36 hours for a bovine animal born in a dairy herd and within 20 days for any other herd.

Please ensure that your cattle are marked with an approved Ear Mark.
