## **Special Conditions of Sale, Autumn 2016**

1. Steer and heifer calves must not be more than fifteen months old or thereabouts at date of sale. Bull calves must not be more than twelve months old at the date of sale.
2. All calves must be properly dehorned. Any calf showing any sign of a horn will be rejected.
3. All calves to be healthy.
4. All heifers must be warranted as not being in calf at the date of sale. This warranty will be as stipulated in the National Conditions of Sale.
5. All steers must be properly castrated. The vendor shall be liable for any claims which might arise as a result of steers not being properly castrated.
6. Bull calves shall be strictly confined to bull calf sections in the sale yard.
7. All calves must be entered on the proper entry form by the closing date and the sale is confined to members of the Brecon and Radnor Suckled Calf Rearers Ltd.
8. Vendors must ensure that all calves are properly double tagged and that correct ear numbers are given to the Auctioneers.
9. Every effort should be made to pen stock in good time on the morning of the sale. Stock not ready when lot number is called will be passed over and relegated to the end of the sale.
10. All calves will be inspected by the Association's Field Officer in the sale yard. The Auctioneer will be asked not to offer for sale any animal which does not comply with these conditions and the lot number removed. The decision of the Association's Officer must be accepted as final in all cases.
11. A levy of  $\frac{1}{2}p$  in the £ will be payable to the Association and will be deducted from payments due in respect of calves sold.
